monday 30 august - madrid

1.20 pm - Arrival into Madrid on Emirates Flights EK433/141 *

tuesday 31 august - sevilla

After a leisurely breakfast, join us on a walking tour through Madrid, including the gorgeous Parque del Buen Retiro and Palacio Real. This afternoon, we'll take a 'stroll' through the Andalusian olive groves from the comfort of Spain's famous AVE Fast train before arriving in Sevilla. Tonight, we're going on a 'tapas' crawl through the fantastic bars in the back streets of Santa Cruz.

wednesday 1 september - sevilla

This morning a very special local is taking us behind the scenes at the Mercado de Sevilla - one of the liveliest fresh produce markets in Andalucía. Learn the difference between chorizo and salchichas, taste fresh olives and watch the stall holders in loud chaotic action. You'll collect a feast of goodies for your traditional Sevillano cooking class and then enjoy the spoils with an alfresco lunch on the terrace.

thursday 2 september - tarifa

Today we're heading to Tarifa, a gorgeous white-washed village and Spain's closest point to Morocco. We'll stop at a fabulous bodega (cellar) in Jerez de la Frontera, the home of Spain's Fino sherry, to see how Fino is made and taste the different varieties. Tonight we'll watch the sunset over the Atlantic at a gorgeous beach bar before dining in a great Moroccan restaurant hidden away in Tarifa's backstreets.

friday 3 september - sanlúcar de barrameda

You'll have the morning to explore Tarifa in your own time before we head north for the best Pescaito Frito (fried freshly caught fish) on Spain's west coast! After lunch, we'll weave through the tiny seaside villages on La Costa de la Luz before arriving in Sanlúcar de Barrameda, a charming village only a stone's throw from UNESCO's World Heritage listed Doñana National Park and a handful of great local beaches.

While Jerez is famous for Fino sherry, Sanlúcar is known for its slightly sweeter, Manzanilla sherry, so today we'll tour a family run bodega to taste the difference. We'll then make our way to our seaside kitchen for an afternoon cooking (and eating!) session with a wonderful local chef.
